Dan Lagatta of Foxboro is being unjustly thrown out on the street Friday, January 26, 2007 at 9:00 A.M. Family Court Judge Beverly Boorstein held a trial while Dan was laid up in a hospital bed and could not attend to defend his rights. This is the same judge caught skipping out of work by an Eyewitness News undercover investigation. Dan never got a fair trial.
